Dear Parents and Guardians,

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our staff, students and families for all their hard work in transitioning to flexible delivery over the past 8 weeks. Although, it was a rapid change to online learning, everyone has adapted incredibly well considering the short time frame we all had.

As you would have seen in the media, the NSW Department of Education (DoE) has announced a return to school on MONDAY 25th May.

Attached is the communication from the DoE, outlining the procedures that all schools will be implementing. You will see that a number of activities are not permitted and there is an emphasis on ensuring a safe and healthy environment for all. Here are some key points about your child's return to Wee Waa High School next week.

Attendance:

- ✓ All students are expected to be at school unless they are **SICK** or fall into one of the health categories at risk (see attachment). Please contact the school if your child is sick so they are not marked as absent.
- ✓ If your child becomes sick during school hours, you will be called to collect them as the sick bay is not operational.
- ✓ Students are expected to be in full school uniform.

Timetables:

- ✓ Students will be given a new timetable on Monday morning in roll call.
- ✓ Bell times will be adjusted until further notice to allow for students to transition back to school and to accommodate for the need to sanitise rooms before each class commences.
- ✓ All periods will be 60 minutes in length and there will be a 15 minute break between classes, and a 30 minute lunch break.
- ✓ Sport will continue to be compulsory for Years 7-10 on Tuesdays and will be operating under the revised policies in sport around minimising social contact and increased hygiene.

Technology

- ✓ **If your child has borrowed a laptop from the school, they need to return it on Monday.**

Assessments and reports

- ✓ Students have / will be informed of any changes to assessment schedules.
- ✓ In line with DoE guidelines on longer reporting timeframes, Years 11-12 will receive reports this term, with years 7-10 receiving them early in Term 3.
- ✓ If parents / guardians have concerns or questions about progress, please contact your child's year adviser over the phone or online, with no parents allowed onsite until further notice.

Food and Water:

- ✓ The canteen will be open. Students will order their recess and lunch at roll call, using a paper bag provided and place their money in the bag. Change will be in the bag when they collect their order.
- ✓ Bubblers are not operational, students need to bring their own water bottle. The refill station is still able to be used.
- ✓ Food is NOT to be dropped off to school during the day.
- ✓ No lunch passes will be permitted.
