The riders had to qualify to play and they competed against strong teams from Coffs Harbour, Merriwa, North Dorrigo and zones from Sydney.

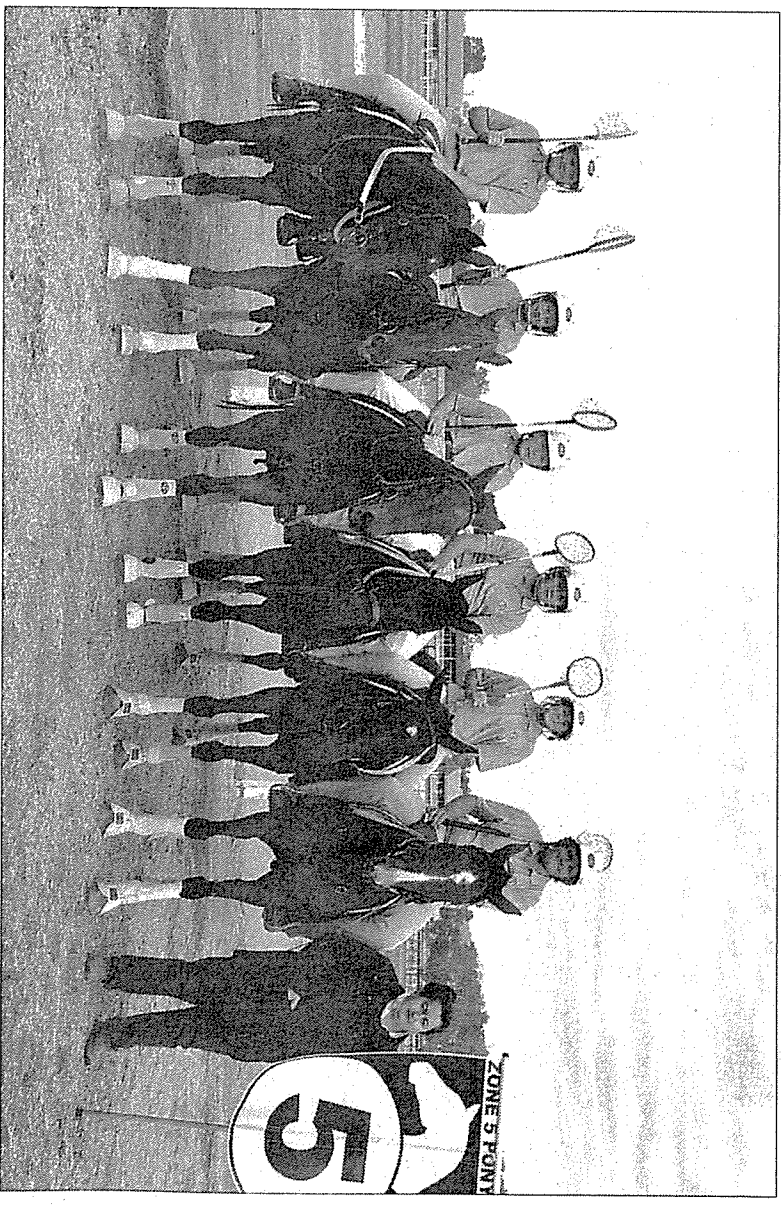
The event covered other horse riding skills.
